**The right eye and the right hand were first a challenge but later through revelation, I read a scripture that read:**



## RIGHT EYE.

**This means things that we think they won't bring harm to us by just looking or watching them. For example, movies most times will damage or shift your way of thinking. Moreso, I watched a documentary where a convicted murderer was first inspired by an action movie where he got interested in violent acts which made him study the whole process of murder through the windows of a car. 
Revelation 1:16

Among the many things that Solomon's right hand did was to impart in the people the wisdom that came to him through revelation from the holy spirit, however he had to cut it off in areas where the kings who benefitted from his wisdom offered their daughters who caused him to commit adultery with other gods against the almighty God. He had to say no to the marriages and if they threatened him not to listen to him, he would have said OKAY and bye.

David's right hand, he fought many of Israel's battles as a vessel to save the Israelites but he let the influence of his right hand led him to steal another man's wife and sentence him to death by battle on the front-line which God condemned and this brought him into repentance.



Out of the bible I heard a story of a youth who refused to take up a youth pastor position because he was weak in staying away from teenage girls. The temptation was strong at the time. Though he was good with the word of God, and this would be his right hand because this would benefit a mass of youths. The honest truth he knew, he would end up sleeping or fornicating with many of these girls and not just one. He turned down this role (cut off his right hand) and God was really pleased because he decided to choose God instead of hell. Hope many understand this. God looked at his heart and he blessed him with more spiritual growth that when God saw he was ready to render his right hand again, the youth pastoral position came around and he took it. This is agape love all the way. Agape love to all the young lives he would have destroyed and Agape love for God who looks at our hearts to bless us and agape love for himself for sacrificing his flesh and later Agape love for the youth later he benefitted.
